- SUBJECT: Chairperson Abzug's Letter to Director Kelley dated October 22, 1975

The Deputy's preliminary view of our position on this request is consistent with that of Jim Adams.

- That we agree to turn over our conclusions, i.e., Tyler and Thornburgh's memoranda declining prosecution;
- (2) That we decline at this time to make any other material or potential witnesses immediately available because this exact matter is under investigation by the Edwards Committee. Adams just this week testified before the Edwards Committee. It is Adams' understanding that the Edwards Committee is continuing their investigation;
- (3) That we agree to make available at some reasonable time in the future, summaries prepared by us, not by the FBI, of the details of the investigation;
- (4) That we in no event agree to make available the FBI 302's or files;
- (5) That we attempt to work out a solution as to interviewing and calling the agents so that this will occur only once and preferably with the Edwards Committee.

Please keep me informed as to the progress we make or don't make.
