LEE HARVEY OSWALD, IS DASH R.
 RE UR CABLEGRAM ONE TEN SIXTY-FOUR.

IMMEDIATELY FURNISH DATA SET OUT IN BUCABLE ONE EIGHT SIXTY-FOUR AND URCABLE ONE TEN SIXTY-FOUR RE YLARIO ROJAS VILLANUEVA AND HIS ALLEGED ASSOCIATION WITH LEE HARVEY OSWALD TO CIA LOCALLY. EXPLORE WITH CIA FEASIBILITY OF HAVING VILLANUEVA INTERVIEWED WITH AID OF A POLYGRAPH. ALSO, FURNISH BUREAU UR RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FURNISHING COMPLETE DETAILS REGARDING DATA FURNISHED BY VILLANUEVA TO APPROPRIATE MEXICAN AUTHORITIES FOR INVESTIGATION BY THE MEXICANS.

 NOTE:

Ylario Rojas Villanueva wrote a letter to Attorney General in Spanish language which was furnished Bureau for translation. We determined Villanueva claimed to be a friend of Oswald and several other individuals in Mexico, who were involved in a plot to introduce communist propoganda into Mexico. We interviewed Villanueva and he indicated he met Oswald in Mexico on two different occasions during 1962 and that Oswald himself and three Cubans discussed introduction of Cuban propoganda into Mexico. He also alleged that Oswald reportedly had laid plans to eliminate President Kennedy. He offered to assist Bureau in resolving matter and travel to conduct appropriate investigation and contact his associates if Bureau paid expenses. Legat, Mexico

NOTE, CONTINUED:

reported Villanueva desperately in need of money and feels his allegation of acquaintance with Oswald is hoax in order to obtain money. Our investigation of Oswald disclosed he was employed full time in Dallas, Texas, during period Villanueva has him in Mexico. Desirable we explore feasibility of having Villanueva polygraphed and also consider furnishing story told by Villanueva to Mexican authorities in order that they can fully resolve this.
