RE ALLEGATIONS YLARIO ROJAS VILLANUEVA. ROJAS INTERVIEWED AT GUADALAJARA TODAY BY TWO FEDERAL SECURITY POLICE REPRESENTATIVES AFTER LATTER HAD BEEN THOROUGHLY BRIEFED BY TWO AGENTS OF THIS OFFICE REGARDING DISCREPANCIES IN ROJAS' STORY UNCOVERED BY INTENSIVE INVESTIGATION IN MEXICO AND U.S. ROJAS ADMITTED FABRICATION IN SIGNED STATEMENT TO SECURITY POLICE REPRESENTATIVES ACKNOWLEDGING ALL STATEMENTS IN HIS LETTER TO ATTORNEY GENERAL KENNEDY AND TO U.S. GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVES CONCERNING OSWALD MATTER ARE COMPLETELY LACKING IN VERACITY AND WERE MADE UP ON HIS OWN INITIATIVE; THAT NAMES HE MENTIONED IN LETTER AND PREVIOUS STATEMENTS WERE TAKEN BY HIM FROM LOCAL NEWSPAPERS; AND ENTIRE MATTER WAS THOUGHT UP BY HIM WITH POSSIBLE RECOMPENSE AS ONLY OBJECTIVE. ENDED STATEMENT BY SAYING HE IS WILLING TO TESTIFY AT ANY PLACE AND ANY TIME CONCERNING HIS FABRICATION.

ORIGINAL OF STATEMENT SIGNED BY ROJAS HAS BEEN MADE AVAILABLE TO THIS OFFICE. ~~LETTER CONCERNING ROJAS' ALLEGATIONS, INVESTIGATION RE DISCREPANCIES IN SAME AND HIS ADMISSIONS OF FABRICATIONS WILL BE SUBMITTED NEXT AVAILABLE POUCH MARCH 10 NEXT.~~
