REBULET MARCH 16 AND SAN ANTONIO AIRTEL AND LHM MARCH 2

LAST RE FM 11 FORM FOR DEPARTURES FROM MEXICO ON OCTOBER 3, 1963.

PRELIMINARY INQUIRY DISCLOSED LINES WERE DRAWN ON FM 11 FORMS TO SEPARATE DIFFERENT DATES AND TO POINT OUT RECORD DATE FOR OSWALD; THAT INFORMATION IN COLUMN 16 WAS PREPARED AT TRAVEL CONTROL SECTION OF MEXICAN IMMIGRATION FROM ORIGINAL TOURIST CARDS TO RECORD DATE AND PLACE OF ISSUANCE THEREOF AS OF POSSIBLE INVESTIGATIVE ASSISTANCE; AND THAT SEPTEMBER 16, 1963 DATE RELATING TO OSWALD THEREON REPRESENTS TYPOGRAPHICAL ERROR AND SHOULD HAVE BEEN SEPTEMBER 17. INVESTIGATION CONTINUING.

RE OSWALD'S MEANS OF DEPARTURE FROM MEXICO. INTENSIVE EFFORTS TO ASCERTAIN SUBJECT'S MEANS OF TRAVEL CONTINUES, AND AIRTEL THIS CONNECTION BEING SUBMITTED NEXT DIPLOMATIC POUCH.
