

Cover Note to Finck Testimony in the Garrison case against Clay Shaw in New Orleans in 1969.

In this 1969 trial the District Attorney of Orleans Parish, Louisiana, charged Clay Shaw as a conspirator in the JFK assassination.

Pierre Fink, one of the doctors who performed the JFK autopsy was called as a witness for the prosecution. As a member of the military and one of the prosecutors at the Bethesda Hospital autopsy Fink was an unfriendly witness for the Garrison camp.

What will be useful from reading a part of the transcript of the trial is central to your class project: What role, if any, did the military play in the JFK autopsy.
