SAC Shanklin advised this morning that Mr. Wade has told him that he is going to be coming up to Washington to testify again before the Warren Commission on June 9th. Wade asked Shanklin if arrangements could be made for his wife and his 4 children to tour the Bureau while the family was in the city. They would very much appreciate having a tour at 9:30 a. m., Tuesday, June 9th. The 4 Wade children range in age between 6 and 13, according to SAC Shanklin.

Shanklin advised that, while we have had considerable trouble with Wade, he felt it would be difficult to refuse to afford a tour for his family. The Dallas Office is, of course, most circumspect with their dealings with Wade and his office.

A regular tour will be afforded Mrs. Wade and her 4 children on the 9th. It is to be noted that no request has been made to meet the Director.
