REFERENCED COMMUNICATION REPORTED TELEPHONIC CONTACT OF
EARL GOLZ, DALLAS MORNING NEWS, WITH SA JAMES P. HOSTY, JR.,
KANSAS CITY DIVISION ON AUGUST 30, 1978.

SINCE THAT DATE, SA HOSTY REVEALED THAT EARL GOLZ ATTEM-
PTED TO CONTACT HIM ONE ADDITIONAL TIME, ON FRIDAY EVENING,
SEPTEMBER 8, 1978 WHEN CALL WAS PLACED TO THE HOSTY RESIDENCE.
SA HOSTY TOLD GOLZ AT THAT TIME THAT HE, HOSTY, WAS PREPARING
TO SIT WITH HIS FAMILY FOR DINNER AND HAD NO STATEMENT TO MAKE.

ON SEPTEMBER 11, 1978, SA HOSTY MADE THE FOLLOWING ORAL
STATEMENT TO JOHN LAWN, ASAC, KANSAS CITY DIVISION RELATING TO

DALLAS NEWSPAPER ARTICLE WHICH QUOTED SA HOSTY AS SAYING HE HAD "BOMBS" TO DROP ON THE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEE.

SA HOSTY AFFIRMED THAT ALL INFORMATION KNOWN TO HIM PERTAINING TO THE ASSASSINATION OF JOHN F. KENNEDY HAD BEEN FURNISHED TO THE SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE AND OR THE HOUSE SELECT COMMITTEE ON ASSASSINATIONS.

SA HOSTY FURTHER ADVISED HE WILL FURNISH A SIGNED STATEMENT ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 1978 AFTER HE HAS REVIEWED THE ORIGINAL ARTICLE CARRIED IN THE DALLAS MORNING NEWS, AND AFTER HE HAS DISCUSSED THE TEXT OF HIS SIGNED STATEMENT WITH HIS WASHINGTON, D.C. ATTORNEY, FRANCIS X. LILLY, 1815 H. STREET, NW, WASHINGTON, D.C.
