Dear Sir:

Those of us who have experience with the Russian method would like to call your attention to an overtone of the Oswald case not noted in television accounts of the events of these past several days.

That overtone is as follows: Mrs. Oswald was apparently allowed to leave Russia with her husband. This fact alone implies a connection between Mrs. Oswald and Russian authorities. In your investigation of this case, please at least consider this possibility.

The initial way to determine if there is a connection between Mrs. Oswald and the Russian authorities is to find out how she left Russia, and how she entered the United States. There is also the possibility of a connection between her and Mr. Ruby, although this is sheer speculation.
