## RE: MARINA OSWALD

On 11/29/68, Mr. KELLEY, who is in charge of the Secret Service Special Detail in Dallas, advised that MARINA OSWALD was being moved from the Inn of the Six Flags on the morning of 10/30/63 and would reside at the home of JIM MARTIN at residence 11611 Farrar Street, Dallas, Texas, DAvis 7-6509. Mr. KELLEY advised MARTIN was Assistant Manager at the Six Flags Inn. Mr. KELLEY advised that his inquiries reflected that MARTIN was a reputable and substantial citizen, and inasmuch as he had volunteered to accommodate the OSWALD family, the move would be effected. KELLEY said Secret Service protection for Mrs. OSWALD and her family would continue.

Our indices are negative and do not reflect any identifiable information concerning MARTIN.

Mr. FRED BROWN, General Manager of the Inn of the Six Flags, who is a contact of this office, advised on 11/29/63 that JIM MARTIN is Resident Manager at the Inn of the Six Flags and was there on last June 15, 1963, when Mr. BROWN took over as manager. He said that MARTIN had previously been with the Statler-Hilton in Dallas as credit manager and subsequently had worked with the Carte-Blanche Credit Company. He said he has great respect for MARTIN's character and ability and could recommend him as a substantial citizen. He said MARTIN's father is the construction engineer for Bell Telephone at St. Louis,
