INFORMATION FROM [redacted] IS TO BE REPORTED IN A SEPARATE REPORT. THE FOLLOWING IS FOR LEAD PURPOSES ONLY, RESULTS OF WHICH WILL BE REPORTED IN THE REGULAR REPORT.

On March 3, 1964, [redacted] advised that MARINA and KATHERINE FORD mentioned an acquaintance named ZINA, not further identified. This individual, according to informant's information, was born, apparently, in Turkey or Moldavia, but claims she was born in the Soviet Union and resided in Turkey. She is of Jewish origin and is described as an attractive person, but uncouth.

Could be Elena Hall

An acquaintance named LELIA, not further identified, was also mentioned [redacted]

b7d

Informant stated LYDIA, not further identified, was the person who told Mrs. FORD that LEE HARVEY OSWALD and MARINA had gone to New Orleans when MARINA was pregnant. On that occasion Mrs. FORD met LYDIA in a store. (It should be noted LYDIA is possibly identical to LYDIA DYMITRUK, previously interviewed in this matter.)

LEADS:

It is suggested that efforts be made to identify ZINA, LYDIA and LELIA and to determine the acquaintanceship or connection with the OSWALDS.
