Information came to the attention of the Dallas Office that MARINA OSWALD, wife of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, assassin of the MARINA OSWALD, wife of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, assassin of the President, planned to establish residence at 629 Belt Line Road, Richardson, Texas, on 2/29/64. When all was in readiness for the actual installations, moved to en-the-spot supervision. He co-ordinated all activities from the scene and insured complete protection of the Bureau's interest, all equipment and personnel involved.

The sensitivity and absolute mecessity that detection not be made was not only due to the nature of the installation, but also due to the worldwide prominence of MARINA OSWALD. Had detection been made, the effect on the national reputation would have been most detrimental.

It was through the highest caliber of on-the-spot supervision during the placing and removal of the installations and continuing day-to-day supervision during the operation that this delicate and sensitive undertaking was completed in the highest of Bureau traditions.

Due to the efficient, painstaking supervision on the part of throughout the entire operation and the manner in which he surpassed the obstacles relating to the successful installations, operation and removal of the surveillances, I receive an incentive award.
