Even the representation of Reolina Gould's Bureau Comptroller testimony in attachment 62-10900-976 is less than faithful, which is necessary to the FBI's concoction of false paper to cover itself in its Cosselion efforts.

So you can understand, first, this begins with Dallas records not provided, the actual records, of whatever and any form, of the FBI's interrogations of Haring. You should also understand that although she was a witness to nothing relating to the assassination she was connected with the right witness against her husband, under such conditions that Bureau Comptroller records indicate that a study was made of the legality and propriety.

For this to be accomplished the FBI had to blackmail her - and without any doubt at all it did, contrary to this particular record. She was told, according to other FBI records, what she did testify to, that if she wanted to remain in the U.S. she would have to "cooperate," which in plain English meant say what was desired. To pull this off the FBI made arrangements for a particular New York FBI official to be in on it and apply the first pressure. (Note <sup>initial</sup> to New York for no stated reason on page 3.) It then arranged to have no witness by having her Secret Service guards removed. And then, in the FBI's own version in another record, it laid it out straight. She capitulated and said whatever was asked of her, explaining this later to the Comptroller by saying that in her earlier statements she had lied.

The affidavits referred to were accepted and they do not tell the whole truth.

Here there is character assassination to cover the Bureau, again with less than full fidelity. The FBI knew, for example, that the Valker story came from her thus agent, as did other dubious statements that appeared to be corroboratable. (page 3)

All the withheld information, which always was historically important, becomes more important because such misleading records were generated by the FBI to cover itself.
