LEE HARVEY OSWALD, aka

At 3:15 PM today, Inspector TOM KELLEY of Secret Service advised me that Mrs. MARINA OSWALD has today retained an attorney, and it is his understanding that she has retained this attorney strictly to handle her financial affairs, such as the possibility of writing articles, books, TV appearances, etc. He stated that this attorney had been out today and had talked to her. It was his understanding that JAMES HERBERT MARTIN where Mrs. OSWALD is presently staying, had arranged for this. KELLEY stated he understood that he was not a criminal lawyer, but was strictly a civil lawyer, and as far as he knew, there had been no objection to continuing interview of her, as he was not in any way concerned with anything except the money she might make out of this thing.

A search of the indices reflects that one JOHN MILTON THORNE was interviewed as a Special Agent applicant in April, 1951. He was unfavorable recommended, and all papers forwarded to the Bureau. It is noted he was supposed to receive a L.L.B. from Southern Methodist University in June, 1951. (Dallas file 67-1-3126 A)
