At the request of the President's Commission we instructed Dallas to interview Marina Oswald concerning the allegation that [redacted] at a Washington hotel during the time she was in Washington testifying before the President's Commission. Attached teletype sets forth results of this interview wherein Marina Oswald admits [redacted] with Martin at Willard Hotel, Washington, 2-7-64. [redacted] done with her consent and no force used by Martin. [redacted] occurred following the withdrawal by Secret Service of its surveillance of Oswald. She alleges that while in Washington, Secret Service Agent Leon Copadze told her there were rumors Martin loved her and rumors might be detrimental and lead to her deportation. We are disseminating details in attached to the President's Commission today.
