est to nottantegable President, november 29,1963 DALLAS, TEXAS With reference to prior telephone call today indicating a note in the Russian language had been located in a cookbook that Mrs. Buth Paine had given to the Irving, Texas, Police Department for transmittal through Secret Serviceto Krs. Lee Harvey Oswald. in In interview with Mrs. Orwald today, Mrs. Oswald admits that some time last Spring, the date she cannot remember, her husband came into their house on Neeley Street in a very excited condition and immediately turned onthe radio. She inquired as to what was wrong and Oswald admitted that he hadshot at General Walker but did not know whether he had hit and wanted to hear on the radio whether or not he had. Mrs. Oswald stated that she threatened to go to the police if Oswald ever again made any such attempt to shoot anyone. She said she kept this note so that she could use it to threaten Oswald inthe event he thouhgt up some other crazy scheme. He told Mrs. Oswald that General Walker was leading the Fascist organization in Dallas and it was best to remove him. It is noted that General Walker was shot at while he was inhis home on April 10, 1963. also noted that Oswald and his wife left Dallas, Texas, onApril 29 and went to New Orleans, Louisians, The rifle slug that was shot at General Walker was located in his home and hasbeen inthe possession of the Dallas Police Department since that time. The fact that this wifle slug was located has been discussed previously last April with the Police Department and the Bure volunteered to make an examinationof this alug but no request for such examination was ever made by the Dallas Police Department. The slug in question has beenpicked up by Bureau agents inasmuch as there was a possibility based oncurrent developments that Osvald might have shot at General Walker and the bullet slug was transmitted today and is en routeon an evening plane to the Bureau Laboratory for examination, 'In view of these developments the original note in Russian is being retained in Dallas until Dallas can have an opportunity to runous all the remifications and take any other action that is necessary codes in this necessary.
