MARINA OSWALD INTERVIEWED AGAIN TODAY. SHE WAS ASKED
ABOUT THE LETTER WRITTEN IN RUSSIAN WHICH HAD BEEN FOUND
A COOK BOOK AT THE PAINE-S HOUSE. MARINA ADVISED SHE HAD FOUND

THIS LETTER IN A ROOM WHERE OSWALD KEPT HIS THINGS AT THE
NEELEY STREET ADDRESS ONE NIGHT LAST SPRING. ON THIS NIGHT
OSWALD, WHO HAD TOLD HER THAT HE WAS GOING

TO ATTEND A TYPEWRITING CLASS AT THE DALLAS EVENING SCHOOL,
CAME RUSHING INTO THE HOUSE AROUND MIDNIGHT VERY PALE AND
AGITATED. HE IMMEDIATELY TURNED ON THE RADIO AND LAY ON THE

BED IN A VERY AGITATED CONDITION. MARINA ASKED HIM WHAT WAS
WRONG, AND HE REPLIED THAT HE HAD BEEN SHOT BY GENERAL WALKER
BY SHOOTING AT HIM WITH A RIFLE, AND THAT HE DID NOT KNOW
WHETHER HE HAD HIT HIM OR NOT. SHE BECAME ANGRY AT HIM FOR
