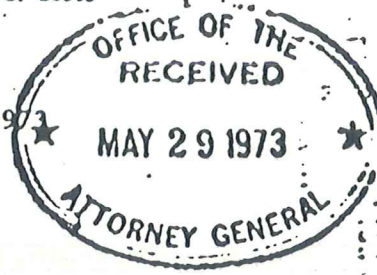

Dear Mr. Attorney General:

Mr. Edward R. Slemmer of 136 South Fulton Street, Allentown, Pennsylvania, 18102 has requested the Subcommittee's assistance in the declassification of certain documents of the Warren Commission. These particular documents were classified at the request of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The documents are as follows:

- CD 557 3B - re Oswald's alleged suicide 3/4/64
- CD 794 2 - "Lee Harvey Oswald" re Elizabeth Catlett Mora 4/10/64
- CD 880 3B - re Oswald's safe deposit boxes, Laredo, Houston 4/30/64
- CD 1212 3B - Lee Harvey Oswald re checks 6/23/64

Mr. Slemmer said the sources of confidential information could be blocked out if that question causes any problem.

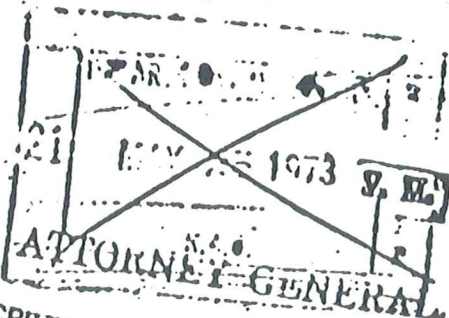
It is my belief that our Government should try to declassify as much information as possible when there is no further need for classification.
