Dear Mr. Weisberg:

In the course of the Naval Investigative Services's search of its records in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, that office surfaced two pertinent documents which were referred to this Agency for determination as to their releasability.

We have completed our review of these documents and our determinations are shown below.

Enclosed is a copy of segregable portions of a CIA memorandum dated 6 May 1964. Deletions were made under the exemption provisions of FOIA subsections (b)(1) and (b)(3). An explanation of these exemptions is enclosed. The denying official for these deletions is Louis J. Dube, the DO Information Review Officer.

I am informing you of your right to appeal the above decision by addressing your appeal to the CIA Information Review Committee, in my care. Should you decide to do this, please explain the basis of your appeal.

Enclosed is a "Classification Cancelled" copy of Naval Message R102012Z containing CIA electrical dissemination No. 74673. There are no deletions of CIA-originated material from this document.

We wish to apologize for the length of time it has taken us to complete the processing of your request. We have been inundated, however, by a large number of requests over the past several years. Under the circumstances, we can only do our

best to apportion our time and efforts in a manner calculated to satisfy all of our requesters. Thus, we have adopted the policy of first-received, first-answered. Thank you for your patience and consideration while we were completing the processing of your request.
