Thank you <u>very</u> much for your letter of October 20 with which you forwarded two (previously disclosed) documents, referred to you by NIS, in response to my May 1977 request. I'm certainly glad to see that <u>outside</u> the CIA some of my old FOIA requests are not completely forgotten and ignored.

May I ask you once again when you intend to act on some of my requests of the CIA that are even older than this one to NIS and the appeal from withholdings in incomplete compliance with my January 1971 request?

If my memory is not flawed, I have also appealed denial of a fee waiver for which I believe I do and did qualify.

In fairness and in the hope of avoiding unnecessary litigation, I inform you that I have copies of CIA records that were not provided in response to my 1971 request and of internal CIA records disclosing the deliberate deception of the official responding to that request.
