SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY

On 11/29/63, it was determined from Inspector TOM KELLEY, U. S. Secret Service, that a large manilla envelope was mailed to MARINA OSWALD, containing several letters received at the residence of RUTH PAINE that were meant for MARINA OSWALD. This large envelope which contained these letters bore the return address of Mrs. WILLIAM HYDE, The Quadrangle, Oberlin, Ohio. Inside was a letter which indicated Mrs. CAROL E. HYDE, address The Quadrangle, Oberlin, Ohio, was the mother of Mrs. RUTH PAINE. From this letter, it would appear that Mrs. RUTH PAINE has gone to her mother's residence in Oberlin, Ohio.
