departure. She said she would like to correct her previous statement concorning the visit of two agants sither on November 3 or 4, 1963, as previously reported, as she is sure now the visit was on November 1, 1963.

Marina Ocuald wont on to may that her husband was with them over the weekend of Hovenbor 2 and 3, 1963, that he did not go any place, that the following veckend of Hovenbor 9 and 10, he also spent with them, and that it was the veckend of Hovenbor 16 and 17 when he did not show up at their house. Marina Ocuald further cold that she did not think herhusband hed the rifle any place but Hes. Faine's garage as she or Mrs. Faine would have even him with the rifle during the weekends. According to Marina Ocuald, she saw the rifle in the garage about three weeks prior to November 22nd and she thinks that the rifle was taken out of the garage by her husband in the morning of the accordination of the Fredident.

Excina Oswald was further questioned concerning the attempted assessination of former Constal Valker by her husband on April 10, 1953, and whether any one else know booide hercelf about this act. She stated that the day of her husband's errest and after she and her mother-in-law returned to the Paine's from visiting lae Ocuald at the City Jail, she told her nother-in-law that she thought Lee use respensible for shooting the President as he previously unsuccessfully tried to kill General Malker with his rifle. The very Marina Ocwald was describing the later picture, it leaves very little doubt that this picture is ontitled "Seddenly" starsing Frank Sinstra.

Harine Osweld also was asked for assistance in transcribing verious names, words and addresses written in Receice by her husbend in his small notebook, repreduced pages of which were furnished this Service by the FNL. Nothing was found there of interest to this Service except various names of their friends while they were living in Russin, their addresses, and telephone matters, various serves of Government offices, Russian coloudar, proper pronuclation of Russian words, itees to be obtained for Marina's departure from Russia and a hard-dream may of the Frenklin and its vicinity.

Foglish meaning of notations fouri in Lee Oswald's book and written in Russian are set forth by pulss in the adjaced coparate page.
