PROJECTED INTERVIEWS WITH MARINA OSWALD

On 12/30/63 I talked to Inspector DON MOORE at the Bureau and pointed out to him that we have a number of items that we feel we should interview <u>MARINA OSWALD</u> on, but that none of them at this time are extremely urgent. I also pointed out, however, that the local newspapers have indicated that RANKIN and one other member of the Commission may either interview MARINA OSWALD here in Dallas or have her come to Washington for interview, and that I certainly felt that we should conduct our interviews and wind up everything we could prior to her being interviewed by the Commission. He indicated that he did not know at this time exactly when RANKIN might interview her and that there was a possibility that RANKIN might want to have SA BOGUSLAV act as the interpreter.

Inspector MOORE stated he would check with Inspector J. R. MALLEY and see if they could determine exactly what the procedure might be as far as the Commission was concerned.

I suggested that certainly we ought to have BOGUSLAV down here some several days before the Commission came to talk to her and that we had at present sufficient material to take about two separate interviews. He stated he would let me know either December 31st or January 2nd, and at that time we would determine when BOGUSLAV should return from New York.
