

ReBulet, 11/23/63, to Mr. JESSE E. CURRY, Chief of Police, Dallas, Texas, captioned "ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, FBI Lab. #PC-78243BK, Lab No. D-436461AX; Butel to Dallas, 3/18/64.

There are being transmitted under separate cover, via Railway Express, two boxes of ammunition, described below.

One box of 20 rounds of 6.5 M/M Mannlicher-Carcano Western Cartridge Company, ammunition was obtained from JOHN THOMAS MASEN, owner, Masen's Gun Shop, 7402 Harry Hines Boulevard, Dallas, Texas, on March 26, 1964. The cartridges in this box of ammunition are loaded with the hunting-type (soft nose) bullets.

One Box of 20 rounds of 6.5 M/M Manulicher-Carcano Combon Western Cartridge Company, ammunition was obtained from JOHN H. BRINEGAR, owner, The Gun Shop, 11448 Harry Hines Boulevard, Dallas, Texas, on March 26, 1964. The cartridges in this box of ammunition are loaded with the military load.

Masen's Gun Shop and BRINEGAR's gun shop were the only two sources of supply located in the Dallas-Irving
