1. See pp. 6-7 of Marguerite Oswald's account of how she and Marina were handled when under SS custody when they learned Lee was shot. . . .SS did not want to take them to the hospital. By the time they got their Lee was already dead. Indication of the impact on Marina. .
2. Shanklin to file 11/28/'63 He notes on p. 2 that SS has Marina tucked away someplace and FBI no knowledge where she is being held. Also noted that official story of FBI acquisition of thye evidence I the case is being rehearsed here. . . .That Wade wants to turn it all over to the FBI, etc. . .Date of Wade's confirmation of this is 12:00 noon on this date. (Fails to note that all evidence was in hands of FBI on 11/23
1. Ruth Paine's 12/27/'63 letter to Marina. . .Marina was isolated; cut off from all friends by the SS and then the FBI. Exactly how much a friend Ruth was is the tantalizing aspect here. . .
2. Malley to Dallas 11/28/'63 notes that Air Force plane bringing IS Harvey and Agent Bougaslav to Dallas to meet with Marina was leaving WDC at 2:30 and be in Dallas 4:45
3. 11/28/'63 Shanklin to file Key Doc. How SS agrees to allow FBI to move in and take over the handling of Marina This is the doc. in which SS Kelley says he will even "kick the Mother loose" so the FBI (and Harvey) have complete access to Marina. . . .all alone. *****
4. 11/28/'63 Malley to SAC, Dallas This ***** doc sets out in detail what the FBI wants out of Marina and asap. . . .
5. 11/28/'63 Shanklin to File lists questions Sullivan wanted directed at Marina when Boguslav met with her on 11/28. . . .These were questions that related to Oswald and Mexico and New Orleans. . . .Sullivan wanted answers and he wanted them "yesterday." Marina was going to be pumped hard. . .
6. Shanklin to file 11/29/'63 Sullivan wanted to know how the 11/28 interview went. . .In that session Marina told Boguslav that Lee had never

been to Mexico City. . . Meeting was cut short because the baby was sick . .
.Notes to Oday "They are going to bear down."

7. 11/29/63 Heitman to SAC, Relays what Harvey told Marina: citizenship in US was possible if she cooperated with the authorities. . .
8. 9. Hersh book Bobby and Hoover on p. 429 that FBI interrogated Marina 46 times while the WC was in session . . .
9. 11/27 Details of interb=view w/ Marina by Hosty and Brown. . . Marina was not cooperative. . . she was tired of answering questions. Hosty may have been a factor in this. . . .
10. Series of interviews w/ Marina over period 11/26-12/6 recorded by SS Agents

11/30 Malley to SAC, Dallas Indicates that no one could get to Marina once she was under SS "protection." Any business matters or entitlements she was eligible for –like Lee's veteran status had to be cleared for contact with her by the SS> She was totally a ward of the government.
