Note on the Redlich File

The Redlich file was held at the National Archives in Washington, D.C.

Assassination researcher Harold Weisberg received this file as a result of a FOIA action to get into the public domain the Commission's Executive Session for May 30, 1964 when it was originally denied under the exemption that it dealt with highly personal matters. The May 30 session was given over to discussing what action, if any, should be taken in the matter of Norman Redlich. Weisberg argued that since the Redlich File was open for public inspection the exemption grounds were therefore unwarranted.
