
Dear Senator Jackson:

2. Does Norman Redlich have a top secret security clearance as required by Mr J Lee Rankin?
3. Who evaluated the FBI background investigation of Norman Redlich and recommended that he be awarded a top secret security clearance, if he does in fact have one?
4. What does the House Committee on Un-American Activities have to say about the Emergency Civil Liberties Committee and what does the Senate Internal Security Subcommittee have to say about the Emergency Civil Liberties Committee.
