Dear Sir - I would appreciate an explanation of the appointment of the attorney, a professor of law at U. of. University, to the Committee investigating the assassination of former Pres. John F. Kennedy. I have another question - are steps being taken to remove our motto - "In God we trust" from our currency, and other places where it appears? Freedom of religion meant that people were not to be persecuted because of their beliefs. My forebears were Huguenots and driven from France, where there was no freedom of religion at that time. And here now are we being told that we must refrain from the mention of God except possibly in Church? May I ask what your denomination may be?
