It appears from his past record that SALVADOR DIAZ VERNON is sincerely pro-American and was greatly distressed to think that it was desired by any branch of the U.S. government that he take a lie detector test. He admitted listening to many newspaper reporters while in Mexico City and he does not have such speculation, comments and facts attributed with any accuracy to specific sources from whom he received them. Dr. EDUARDO BORRELL NAVARRO is the only person whose name he knew and he therefore attributed everything to him.
