SUBJECT: DISSEMINATION OF COPIES OF
 TESTIMONY BEFORE WARREN COMMISSION
 RE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY

Now that we have received the copies of the testimony which back up the one-volume report of the Warren Commission, dissemination should be made in accordance with the memorandum of Mr. Rosen, dated 9/29/64, covering the dissemination of the original Warren Commission report itself. - 10 - One for each Legal Attache
