Dear Mr. Rankin: Reference is made to your letter of April 7, 1964, requesting this Dureau to conduct further investigation for the purpose of locating a safe-deposit box which Lee Marvey Oswald may have rented in his name, in the name of a member of his immediate family or in any assumed name in Irving, Fort Worth, Dallas, Houston or Laredo, Texas. Our letter of April 30, 1964, transmitted to the Commission results of our investigation in this particular inquiry. We also indicated that we were conducting further investigation concerning a \$25,000 charge which was made on January 7, 1964, against the account at the First Mational Bank of Grand Prairie, Grand Prairie, Texas, entitled "The Oswald Trust Fund." This account was opened on December 5, 1963, by James H. Martin and Marina N. Oswald. Enclosed are two copies of a memorandum dated May 4, 1964, at Dallas, Texas, which sets out results of our additional inquiries regarding the aforementioned \$25,000 charge against the account entitled "The Oswald Trust Fund."

This concludes our investigation in this particular natter.
