We do not intend to take any further action in connection with the unfounded assertions of Mrs. Oswald as recorded in the enclosed memorandum. It may interest you to know that the maiden name of the wife of Special Agent James Fosdy is Janet Ethel Perry. In connection with Mrs. Oswald's concerns concerning former Special Agent John W. Faiz, your attention is invited to the fact that Mr. Faiz has appeared before the President's Commission and has offered sworn testimony concerning the nature and extent of his association with Lee Harvey Oswald.
