This is in reply to your letter of July 5, 1975, concerning the records of the Warren Commission.

The Helms covering letter and second page of the memorandum of April 6, 1964 (CD 708) are the only parts of that appendix in the long memorandum on Oswald's foreign activities that have been released. Enclosed are copies of the following: (1) a page that may be inserted in the appendix to show the withholding of these pages; (2) a copy of the Slawson memorandum on a "Conference with the CIA on March 12, 1964" as it was declassified in 1973 (the paragraph about Yuri Nosenko on the first page was declassified on January 24, 1975); and (3) copies of CIA documents declassified since 1970 that you requested.
