SUPPLIES of Relevant Information on Les Harvey CSMALD at 0700 on 24 November 1963.

1. Our first information on OSWALD came from
Mexico City Car 9 October 1963. It
revealed that on 1 October 1963 Ica CSIAID had been in touch there
with Soviet Consul Valery KOSTIKOV about a telegram which the
Soviet Embassy was supposed to send on him to the Soviet Embassy in
Washington. The data showed that OSWALD had also been at the Soviet
Prises; on 28 September. Traces showed CSWALD was a forest U. S.
defector to the USSR and on 10 Cotober CLA Headquarters notified the
FBI, State and the Mavy (CSWALD had been a Marine). Our Marico Station
was told to pass its information on CSWALD to the Mexico City offices
of the FBI, the Immigration and Maturalization Service and the Embessy.
Since our Agency is not supposed to investigate U. S. citizens abroad
vithout special request, we did nothing further on the case.

2. After the assassination of President Kennedy on 22 Hovember,

Mexico Station, which invediately recalled its earlier report on OSHAID

began researching all its files und records for reports which might relate to him. It turned up pictures of a men believed to be OSHAID entering the Soviet and Caban Rebessies

in October, but when some of these pictures were sent to the FEI in Dallas they proved to be someone other

then CSWALD. Mexico Station has, to date, found no pictures of CSWALD entering the Soviet or Cuben Embassy. 3. The search did reveal more date, however. This information been previously associated with CSWALD because his name is not actually mentioned in it, but the subject metter shows it is about him, This further information covers Maits which CSWALD made to the Soviet and Cuban Erbassies in Merico City between 27 Scotember and 3 October 1963. This has been supplemented by reports on his travel in and out of Mercico obtained by the U. S. Consulate in the border town of Meero Leredo from Mercican Designation Service records. 5. In brief, all this information shows that Lee Harvey CSWALL entered Mexico (apparently by car) at There Laredo ca 26 September 1963, claiming he was a photographer, living in Her Orleans and bound for Mexico City. On 27 September he was in Mexico City to ask for a visa so he could go to Clease, USSR. On 28 September, he was at the Cuban Embassy & It seems that CSWALD ranted a Cultum transit visa so he could go to Coba and wait there for a Soviet

6. On 28 September 1963, OSWALD again visits the Cuban Embassy about the same matter, Jaw man Contract -8. That same day, 3 October 1963, OSHALD drove back into the

United States at the Musvo Laredo-Laredo, Teras crossing point. Ha
