Dear Dr. Wecht:

Enclosed are some documents Jerry Policoff asked me to send you. While we have never met, I am quite familiar with your work and we have many friends in common. Although I still correspond with some Warren Report critics and make rare public appearances to groups such as the Bar Association, I am essentially inactive as far as the case is concerned. I spend my time as a clinical psychologist at the clinic on the letterhead, as coordinator of a free Walk-In Counseling Center, and as a consultant on drug abuse and community psychology problems.

I assume that Burke Marshall is still giving you the run-around with regard to the X-rays and photos. Interestingly enough, he played a somewhat analogous role after the assassination of Malcolm X, when he was still with the Justice Dept. I do not share Ned Crosby's charitable view of him.

The enclosed documents were obtained by me from the archives. Paul Hoch and myself were wondering what they were, having seen them listed in the last batch which were declassified. When they arrived, I realized that Harold Weisberg had sent me copies of them some time ago. These were the documents he convinced the Secret Service (through meetings with Kelly) to make available through the Archives. I had not realized (probably due to not having read one of Harold's letters carefully) that they were in the archives --Harold had left me with the impress on that he had gotten them directly from the Secret Service. So, they are in the public domain, although only due to Harold's efforts. He feels strongly that they are his literary property, and they play an important role in his unpublished manuscript Post Mortem.

I hope this letter finds you in good health and spirits. Please contact me if you would like to discuss anything. I hope that if and when you get access to the X-rays and photos, you will convene a small commission of critics and other experts to discuss their implications.
