'NO DOUBT' THAT

OSWALD KILLED KENNEDY 3.5

The first independent expert to study X-rays of President Kennedy taken after his killing said that they eliminate any doubt that Lee Harvey Oswald fired the fatal shots, the *New York Times* reports.

In a front-page article the newspaper says that Dr John Lattimer, chairman of the Department of Urology at Columbia University, New York, was allowed on Friday to examine the X-rays in the National Archives in Washington.

The *New York Times* says that in an interview at the weekend Dr Lattimer said the X-rays and photographs completely disposed of any doubt about the validity of the Warren Commission's conclusion that Oswald fired all the shots that hit the President in Dallas in 1963.—
