This is in reply to your letter of June 24 concerning records of the Warren Commission.

An examination of pertinent records of the Commission has failed to reveal any indication that the original Lamont pamphlet given to Special Agent John L. Quigley by Lee Harvey Oswald, a copy, or a report concerning the pamphlet was transmitted to the Commission by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. None of the original pamphlets which we received from the F.B.I. bears any identification which would indicate that it is the pamphlet given to Agent Zuigley by Oswald.

Three pages in Commission Document 735 and five in CD897 relate to Corliss Lamont or the "Crime Against Cuba" pamphlet. Copies of these will be sent to you. No records were filed under the name of Jesse Core in the name files of the Commission.
