This is in reply to your letter of August 9 concerning records of the Warren Commission.

We have no original Crime Against Cuba pamphlets except those in CE 3120 and F.B.I. Exhibits 99 and 303.

We did not inquire at the Department of Justice concerning their search for the copy of the pamphlet received by Agent Quigley because we felt that it would be more appropriate for you than for us to make an inquiry concerning the handling of your previous inquiry by the Department. This you have done in your letter to Mr. Christopher of August 9.

We shall prepare and send the rather large number of copies ordered in your letters of June 29 and July 16 as time is available to do so. The work of withdrawing pages from large documents and refiling them is very time-consuming. Some of the copies have been sent to you.
