On 11/21/63 the radie equipment was checked, also 4 walkie-talkies, to ensure perfect working order on 11/22/63.

Five persons at the Trade Mart, including anti-JFK pickets, were arrested after the shets at Dealey Place and charged with conspiracy to commit murder, later changed to tresspassing.

Lt. Cel. George Whitmeyer of US Army was in pilet car with Lumpkin; pilet car riders were supposed to watch for trouble including observation of buildings.

Pilet car departed Leve Field, maintained 1/4 mile or 3 minutes distance from metercade. Lumpkin stepped at Heusten and Elm to notify the traffic efficer that the metercade was 2 or 3 minutes behind.

A record was made of all persons in cars on parking let behind the TSBD (names, phones, addresses and place of work). Cars not removed were checked later in the afternoon for license numbers.

Lumpkin teld Revill to take a team of men and systematically search the 6th fleer, starting from the east wall, to the west wall, checking all bexes, crates, beeks, etc. A "member of the searching party found the rifle" (but no one found the clipboard!).

Pierce Allman get into the building before it was scaled and was allowed to remain. All others including the press were kept out. At 2:45 the ppress was assembled and allowed to go up to the 6th floor and take photos, to interview Rey Truly briefly.
