CUIMET, President, Century Arms, Inc., made available his records and invoices regarding his company's handling of approximately three thousand Smith and Wesson .38/200 British Service Revolvers. Invoices indicate that 2,850 of these revolvers had been shipped to Dav's House of Guns, 2544 Elm St., Dallas, Texas, in orders ranging from 150 to 1,000 guns per order. Total of six shipments had been sent to Dav's House of Guns. Serial numbers of all instant revolvers were double checked with negative results. Mr. OUTMET advised he did not know the names of any wholesale distributors who handled instant type revolvers nor did he know if Dav's House of Guns purchased instant type revolvers exclusively from Century Arms, Inc.
