DAVID GOLDSTEIN, owner, Dave's House of Guns, 2544 Elm Street, Dallas, Texas, checked his records and could locate no record of handling a Smith and Wesson .38/200 British Service Revolver, Serial Number V510210 and assembly number 65248.

Mr. GOIDSTEIN was shown photographs of the above gun, which was taken from LEE HARVEY OSWALD and was the revolver that killed Dallas Police officer J. D. TIPPIT. He said that he felt that this gun was probably handled by GEORGE ROSE & COMPANY, INC., 1225 South Grand Avenue, Los Angeles, California. He said that a number of the above described revolvers had come into the United States on surplus from Canada and were handled by Century Arms, St. Albans, Vermont.

He was shown a photograph of LEE HARVEY OSWALD and could not recall ever seeing this individual. He added that his company did not sell 6.5 mm ammunition.
