On Decenber II, 1963, a vioman who identified
herself as ALICE LEE GRAVSON, 1720 Bolton Street, Baltimore, Maryland, telephoned the Baltimore Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation to advise that while reading the December 14 issue of the Saturday Evening Fost, she noticed a picture of the Texas School Book Depository. The photograph was reportediy taken after the first shot was fired at President KENNEDY. It shows a man standing in the doorway of the Depository Building. Miss GRAYSON stated that the photograph showed the man had features resembling those of IEE HARVEY OSWALD and she believed this photograph might indicate that OSWALD was in a doorway of the building rather than in a window when the president was shot.

Miss GRAYSON had no further infomation conceming this matter.
