Method of examination:

The white cotton dry cleaner's tags have been bound to  
the lower left shirt tail of specimen Q469 and to the left  
collar of specimen Q470. The numbers "00280" appear  
on both tags as well as some additional markings which appear  
to be in Cyrillic.

Labels in the collars of specimens Q455 and Q462 have  
printing in the Russian language. Neither  
specimen appears to have been manufactured in the  
United States.

Specimens Q455 and Q474 boots also have printing in the  
Russian language which appears to be stamped to the inside portions indicating  
they were probably manufactured in Russia.
