1. Alleged Selective Service System contact by LEE HARVEY OSWALD, at Austin, Texas

Date January 2, 19641

As a result of LEE HARVEY OSWALD allegedly contacting the State Headquarters of Selective Service System, Austin, Texas approximately six or eight weeks prior to the death of former President JOHN F. KENNEDY, to get his discharge from the Marine Corps changed from "other than honorable conditions" to "honorable", Mrs. LEE DANIELLY, Assistant Chief, Administrative Division, Selective Service System, furnished this information by letter to the FBI Residency in Austin, Texas. She indicated in her letter that after searching her locator file for the name given her, HARVEY OSWALD, which she could not find, he was referred to the Selective Service Board in Fort Worth, Texas.

Mrs. DIXIE E. WILSON, Chief Clerk, Selective Service System, advised that her records do not show that LEE HARVEY OSWALD contacted the Fort Worth Office after being referred by Mrs. DANIELLY. Mrs. WILSON pointed out that if OSWALD had contacted the board, his file would have such a notation therein.
