Miss ROSALYND LAIDLER, 292 Garfield Place, Brooklyn, New York, interviewed at her residence, furnished the following information:

About one year ago she saw LEE HARVEY OSWALD on the corner of Fulton and Jay Streets, Brooklyn, at a time he was distributing pamphlets for the Fair Play For Cuba Committee. She overheard him talking to another male, unknown, and stating he was unhappy with President KENNEDY. OSWALD made the statement he had purchased a rifle from a mail order house in Chicago, Illinois, and was planning to kill the President.

At this juncture Miss LAIDLER became incoherent and irrational and the interview was concluded because of her condition.
