I have not been writing for two reasons: one is that there have not been any major new developments, the other is the oblivion in which one compiles an index. The major index (subject index) is just about finished; but I keep thinking of new things that should be put into it, and the unspeakable job of checking every reference (which has to be done by volunteers, as a test of accuracy) still has to be done. Then I must arrange a copyright, and then send out feelers with the hope of getting a publisher. Meanwhile, I ran off some copies of a minor index I did some months ago, before tackling the subject index. I have found it useful on occasion and perhaps you will too. As you will see, it is merely a supplement to the Volume XV index, for some but not all the names, indicating the Commission Exhibit numbers. Perhaps if some publisher is interested in the main index, this can be packaged with it. Meanwhile, here is a copy for ~~Y~~ your own use...a very tiny reciprocation for your many thoughtful transmissions.

Sauvage phoned the other night, about the Dallas Morning News article which I sent to several people. He was most interested and wanted to do a story on it but wished to consult Lobenthal first about the legal position. L is away and I don't know if S succeeded in reaching him. However, you will be interested to learn that Sauvage had just returned from Los Angeles, where he covered the Watts story; he said that he took your address with him, intending to contact you, but was prevented from trying by the press of work and deadlines.
