

On November 26, 1963, the following film processing companies were contacted at Dallas, Texas, by SA HENRY J. OLIVER, and furnished a form to place in each package of processed film. This form requested that the owner of the film contact the local FBI Office if they had any photographs depicting the scene at the time of the assassination of President KENNEDY.
