JACK A. WEAVER, 829 Fidelity Union Life Building, Dallas, Texas, during the KENNEDY motorcade on November 22, 1963, at Dallas, took a Polaroid photograph of the President's automobile which depicts the automobile and its occupants as the automobile made a right turn onto Houston Street from Main Street. In the background of the photograph, in the left hand section, appears the seven-story building housing the Texas School Book Depository. From the time this photograph was taken until the time of President Kennedy's assassination, the automobile traveled one block on Houston Street at the TSBD building, then made the left turn on Elm Street in front of the building, and proceeded to the point where President KENNEDY and Governor CONNALLY were hit by the assassin's bullets.

Mr. WEAVER made available this Polaroid photograph and it has been forwarded to the FBI Laboratory for enlargement and study.
