Mr. JAMES H. HANKINS, residence 3444 Maple Leaf Lane, employed Production Department, Sound & Music, 118 Cole Street, Dallas, telephone RI 2-4301, advised on November 22, 1963, he walked from his place of employment to the Stemmons Expressway to see the Presidential motorcade pass. He advised that he saw what appeared to be the President's car approaching at an estimated speed of 60 - 70 miles an hour and he took a photograph of this car with a Polaroid Camera. Mr. HANKINS stated he was standing on the median strip of Stemmons Expressway facing northeast about opposite the Pearl Beer Waterfall sign.

Mr. HANKINS stated that shortly after taking this photograph someone with a portable radio told him the President had been shot. He stated he later had two enlargements made of this photograph; one he gave to his son and the other he gave to the receptionist in his office.

Mr. HANKINS made available the ~~polaroid photograph~~ taken and requested that it be returned to him.
