BEN ALEXANDER, owner of Alexander Associates, real estate agency, 2931 Lemmon Avenue, advised that he personally rented half of a duplex at 2928 Lemmon to Mr. and Mrs. BERNARD B. HULLER during the first part of October 1963. Mr. and Mrs. HULLER and six children lived in the duplex for approximately one week and, when he attempted to collect the balance of the rent, they had moved.

At the time ALEXANDER rented the half of the duplex, Mr. and Mrs. HULLER were driving a black panel truck, about a 1950 model, bearing New Jersey license, the number not recalled.

ALEXANDER described Mr. HULLER as a white male, about 35, 5'8", 145 pounds, olive complexion, blond hair, blue eyes, well educated, beatnik type. He described Mrs. HULLER as a white female, about 35, 5', 120 pounds, brown hair, heavy build.

Mr. ALEXANDER advised the HULLERS appeared to be transients and could furnish no information as to their whereabouts.
