AT DALLAS, TEXAS:

On January 28, 1964, Mrs. MARTHA KNOWLES, Hidell Hardware Company, 4507 Travis, advised WILLIAM H. HIDELL (deceased) was formerly connected with Hidell Hardware Company, and his wife, Mrs. WILLIAM H. HIDELL, also known as JACKIE HIDELL, had an interest in the company until about two years ago when her interest was purchased by KNOWLES.

WILLIAM H. HIDELL, JR., son of WILLIAM H. HIDELL (deceased), is an architect with offices at 3000 Turtle Creek Plaza, Dallas. WILLIAM H. HIDELL, JR., has never been connected with Hidell Hardware Company.

According to Mrs. KNOWLES, there is no ALLEN HIDELL, JR., connected with this hardware company, and, to her knowledge, there has never been an ALLEN HIDELL in Dallas, Texas.

On January 28, 1964, WILLIAM H. HIDELL, JR., 3000 Turtle Creek Plaza, furnished the following information concerning the HIDELL family:

His father, WILLIAM H. HIDELL, SR., (deceased), had three brothers, HENRY ROBINSON HIDELL, CHARLES MAXWELL HIDELL and ALLEN HIDELL. The family name was originally HENDELBERG but was changed to HIDELL.

WILLIAM H. HIDELL, JR., age 42, was born in Dallas, Texas, and has lived his entire life in Dallas, with the exception of a short time as a small boy in Fort Worth, Texas. His uncle, ALLEN HIDELL, eldest of the four HIDELL brothers, has never been in Dallas, Texas, to his knowledge, and it is his recollection that the family lost touch with ALLEN HIDELL approximately thirty years ago, at which time he was reportedly on the West Coast and had some connection with the yacht business.

WILLIAM HIDELL, SR., does not know if his uncle, ALLEN HIDELL, had any children, and he has never known of an ALLEN HIDELL, JR.
